CALL FOR ABSTRACTS:

The organizing committee invites submissions of original work related to interventional endoscopy for consideration of presentation at T-CAP 2015, **from February 1 to May 31**. We will accept 6 abstracts as oral presentation, and some as poster presentation. The abstracts must be submitted to **SECRETARIAT by e-mail** in English with **contact information of corresponding author** and must not exceed 250 words. Abstracts should include four sections: objective, methods, results, conclusion. Confirmation of acceptance or rejection will be e-mailed to the corresponding address by June 15, 2015. Authors of accepted as oral presentations will receive a travel grant (\$1,000 for international attendees and \$500 for domestic attendees). We will select a Best Oral and a Best Poster presentation, and give award.
